2. My contributions are not of an advertising nature and are directly related to the objectives of the Campaign.
3. I respect the confidentiality and intellectual property rights of the information shared during the Campaign. I do not seek to exploit the ideas, innovations and projects initiated here, to commercial purposes and / or at the expense of any third person / group.
4. I acknowledge that the views and opinions expressed in the context of this campaign do not necessarily reflect the official policy or position of the North-South Centre of the Council of Europe.
5. I acknowledge that participation shall be without prejudice to the individual positions of Council of Europe member States on any issue.
