Thematic Workshop V – Freedom of Expression, Pluralistic Media and Access to information: **Areas of possible intervention**

Stemming from the discussions hold within the workshop concerning the results of the need assessment carried out in **Lebanon**, **Libya**, **Morocco and Tunisia** and the identified actions proposed by partners in their country profiles, identified **priority actions** can be summarized around **four (4)** <u>Areas of possible intervention</u>:

- **1)** To encourage **the transformation of the traditional, legacy media sector** to respond to the digital challenge
- **2)** To foster measures aiming at reinforcing **quality journalism** such as capacity building and awareness raising on media reporting on elections, hate speech and disinformation as well as on safety of journalists
- 3) To support the further alignment of existing or building legal framework on freedom of expression in line with CoE standards
- 4) To sustain the expressed interests of two countries of the region to initiate the process aiming at examining the possibility of ratification of the <u>Convention on Access to Official Documents (CETS No205)</u> (*Tromsø Convention*).

Country tailored actions and regional actions have been included in the workplan for the South Program V, Media component, C11.

This component will have a special focus on <u>LIBYA</u> where a three-axes-cooperation will be initiated; it will consists of initiatives intending:

- 1) To support Capacity building of the Central Committee of Local Elections (CCLE).
- 2) To clarify the legal framework of the operating environment of the **General Authority for Media Monitoring Content (GAMMC).**
- 3) To reinforce professional standards and ethic codes for Libyan journalists.
