SUBJECT: Declaration on Complaint No. 2022/1: New Complaint: Serbia: Alleged Destruction of Habitats in the Area of Novi Sad Due to Proposed Construction of Infrastructure Projects

On the occasion of the submitted Complaint No. 2022/1: New complaint: Serbia: Alleged destruction of habitats in the area of Novi Sad due to the proposed construction of infrastructure projects, submitted by the Secretariat of the Bern Convention in the Council of Europe submitted on behalf of the NGO "World and the Danube", we hereby inform you of the following:

In 2021, the Inspectorate for Environmental Protection of the Provincial Secretariat for Urbanism and Environmental Protection received three petitions regarding the usurpation of public natural resources, one of which is related to the Kamenjar location and the other two to Kamenicka Ada.

The report related to the usurpation of the public natural resource on Kamenjar was forwarded by Nemanja Janković, in which it is stated that the beach has been usurped and that illegal construction is being carried out.

As the report is not within the competence of the Provincial Inspectorate for Environmental Protection, it was forwarded to the City Administration for Inspection Affairs of the City of Novi Sad, of which the applicant was informed in a timely manner.

Reports regarding the usurpation of public natural resources and the usurpation and illegal felling of trees at the site "Kamenicke Ade" on plot 7390/1 KO Novi Sad 11 on Kamenicka Ada, were forwarded by the NGO "World and Danube"

Regarding the application, the Provincial Inspection addressed the Provincial Institute for Nature Protection, Novi Sad, for an expert opinion regarding the allegations in the application, ie whether the allegations in the application are part of an ecological network or a habitat of strictly protected species.

After receiving the answer from the Provincial Institute for Nature Protection, Novi Sad, the Provincial Inspectorate for Environmental Protection, as incompetent to act, forwarded the report to the City Administration for Inspection Affairs of the City of Novi Sad.

The site in the application does not form part of the habitat of strictly protected and protected wild species. It is located on the parcel 7391/2 KO Novi Sad 11 and according to the culture it is registered as a forest of the 3rd class and it was accepted and forwarded to the hunting and forestry inspection, of which the applicant was informed in a timely manner.
