Introduction

This document presents some of the key events and achievements of 2017 in the fields of culture, cultural heritage and landscape. Related web links have been included for more detailed information.

Culture

- Culture and digitisation

In September 2017, the Ministers' Deputies adopted <u>Recommendation CM/Rec(2017)8 to member States on "Big Data for culture, literacy and Democracy"</u>.

- 4th Council of Europe Platform Exchange on Culture and Digitisation

The 4th Platform Exchange on Culture and Digitisation was organised by the Council of Europe in co-operation with the Center for Art and Media (ZKM) at the latter's headquarters in Karlsruhe on 19-20 October. The event revealed the potential of digital tools in Culture, Arts and Science as a strong resource for empowering democracy for culturally competent citizens. The debates generated the substance of the draft Recommendation on Culture's contribution to strengthening the internet as an emancipatory force [see document CDCPP(2018)8].

- Compendium of Cultural Policies and Trends

The Association of the Compendium of Cultural Policies and Trends was inaugurated in October 2017 to support the former Council of Europe Information System of the same name. It currently has 15 members.

- Indicator Framework on Culture and Democracy (IFCD)

Drawing on data collected within the IFCD, the results of a novel survey of internet users conducted by Dalia Research and other reliable sources, the second thematic report on culture and democracy concludes that targeted support for online participation in culture and politics could make a positive contribution to building and maintaining inclusive, democratic societies. It also states that Europeans don't go online so much anymore; they are online.

- Landscape Award of the Council of Europe

Thirteen <u>Applications</u> were presented by the States' Parties to the European Landscape Convention to the Secretary General of the Council of Europe for the 5th Session of the Landscape Award of the Council of Europe (2016-2017). On 27 September 2017, the Committee of Ministers adopted the <u>Decisions of the CM</u> on the Award, Special Mentions and Recognitions, in accordance with Resolution CM/Res(2008)3 on the rules governing the Landscape Award of the Council of Europe, and on the recommendation of the International Jury (Report of the Jury) and of the CDCPP (Proposals of the CDCPP to the CM).
