Regarding future invitees, the Group is invited to decide which possible ad hoc experts it wishes to invite to its future meetings to contribute to the general discussion during the meeting and to make short presentations on specific themes.

It is recalled that during its 88<sup>th</sup> meeting, the CDDH took note of the on-going work of the Group, in particular the draft outline and the planning (doc. <u>CDDH(2017)R88</u>, § 9) and authorised the Group to hold an additional 7<sup>th</sup> meeting in 2019.

Furthermore, welcoming the high number of member States which had participated in the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Group, the CDDH agreed that, in the future, the costs of representatives from these States could also be covered by the budget of the Council of Europe, subject to the availability of budgetary resources and according the following rotation system:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting (3–5 April 2018) and 5<sup>th</sup> meeting (March 2019): Albania, Austria, Azerbaijan, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Greece, Russian Federation, United Kingdom
- 4<sup>th</sup> meeting (25–28 September 2018) and 6<sup>th</sup> meeting (May 2019): Greece, Poland, Romania, Russian Federation, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom
- 7<sup>th</sup> meeting (September 2019): It is envisaged that the Council of Europe will cover the costs of all the participants.
