He holds a BSc in Sociology and Social Anthropology from Brunel University London. He graduated with a Sociology PhD from the London School of Economics. Dr Moskoff has been appointed as National Rapporteur of Greece on Trafficking in Human Beings since 2013. Since 2001 he works as an Expert Minister Counsellor on Human Security and Trafficking in Human Beings at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Greece. During his appointment in Hellenic AID (Agency for International Development, Ministry of Foreign Affairs) he was in charge of the Human Security Network and Public Private Partnerships against Trafficking in Human Beings. From 2004 to 2008, he coordinated the Inter-ministerial Committee and drafted two National Action Plans (2004 and 2006). In 2008 he was appointed to the Office of the Secretary General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and coordinated an informal national coordination mechanism to monitor and combat THB. In his capacity as National Rapporteur, his main field of interest and expertise is inter-agency cooperation, identifying potential partners in prevention and promoting new partnerships with a view to raise public awareness, educate competent authorities and tackle the 'demand side' of Trafficking in Human Beings including the private sector. Dr. Moskoff is also a representative of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs at the Greek National Commission for Human Rights (NCHR). Throughout his diplomatic career, Dr. Moskoff has been spearheading Greec's commitments to Human Security and Human Rights. Prior to his current position he has also worked with the Migration Policy Institute, as a lecturer at Panteion University, and has written and published extensively (the Hellenic Foundation for Foreign and European Policy (ELIAMEP), the Defense Analysis Insti
