

Purpose of the survey

Prior to the 10th evaluation cycle of the CEPEJ, and before publishing the 2024 edition of the CEPEJ Evaluation Report a survey was carried out among CEPEJ Members and National Correspondents for the purpose of:

- better understand how the different parts of the Report are perceived and used
- measure the visibility of the Report at national level
- evaluate the extent to which the Report meets users' needs and expectations
- identify eventual problems and thus be able to suggest improvements
- Improve the next issue of the Report

Methodology for the survey

- **Size:** Short survey of 15 questions on the content, visual presentation and promotion of CEPEJ Report
- **Duration of answer:** 10 minutes
- **Distribution:** online
- **Target audience:** CEPEJ members and National Correspondents
- **Period of response:** one month
- **Additional elements:** Workshops

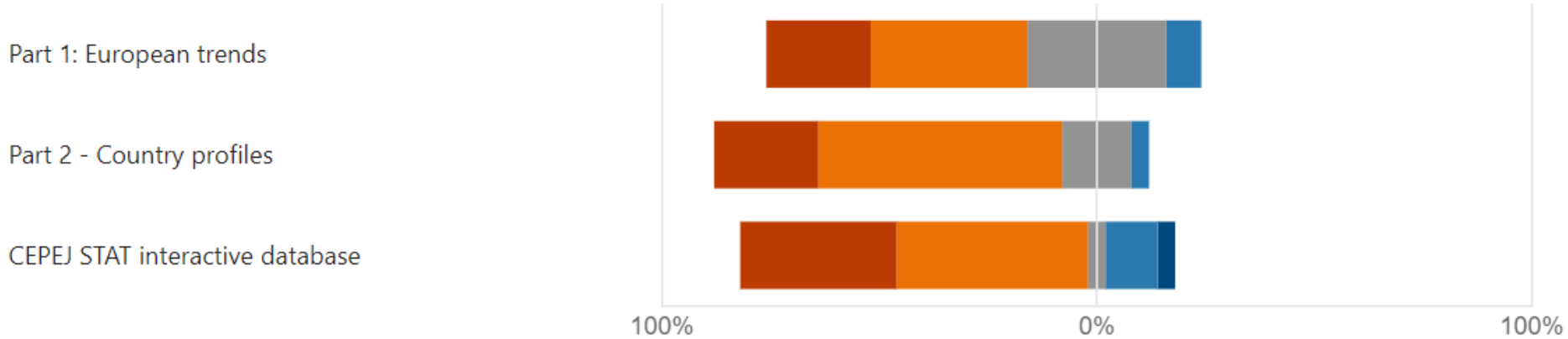

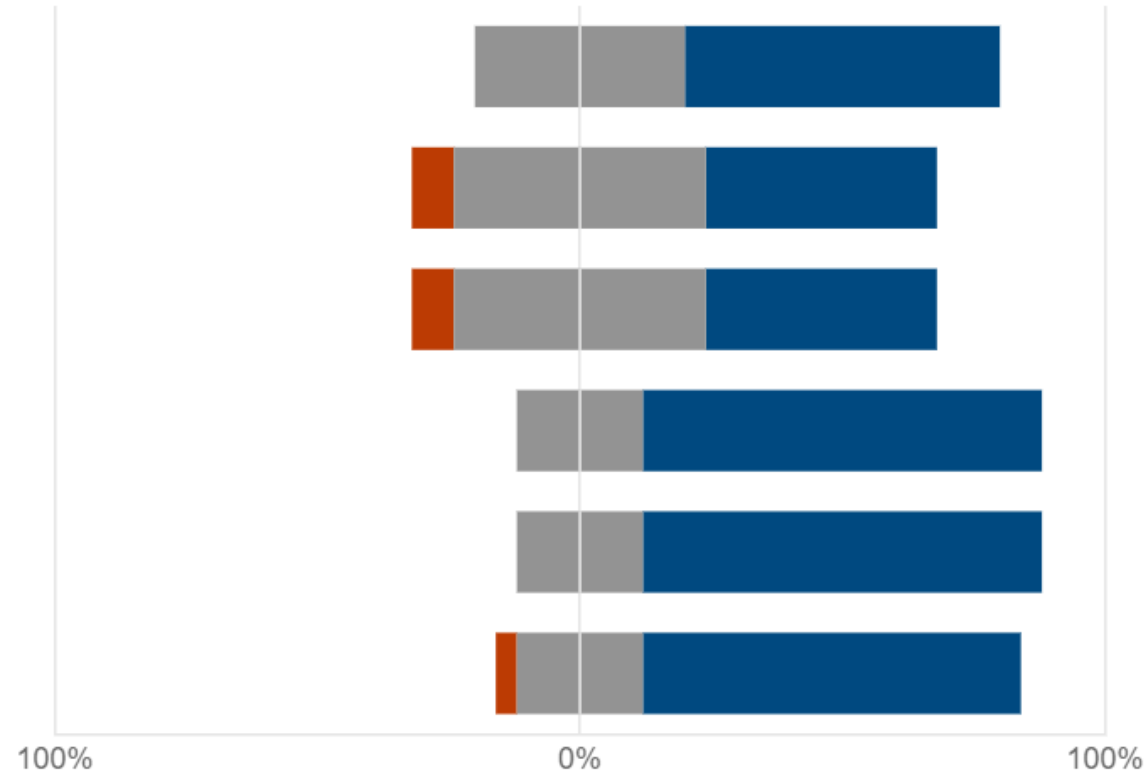
The level of complexity of the interpretation of data analysed in the report.

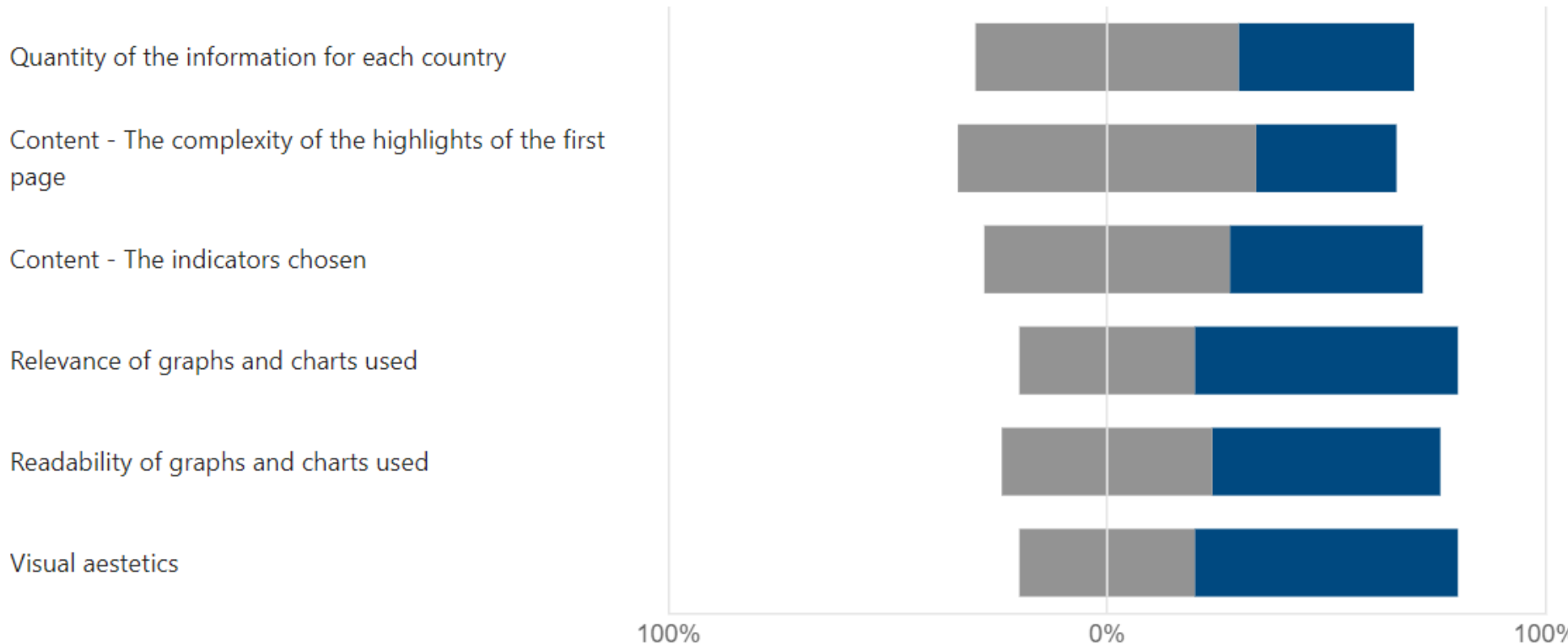

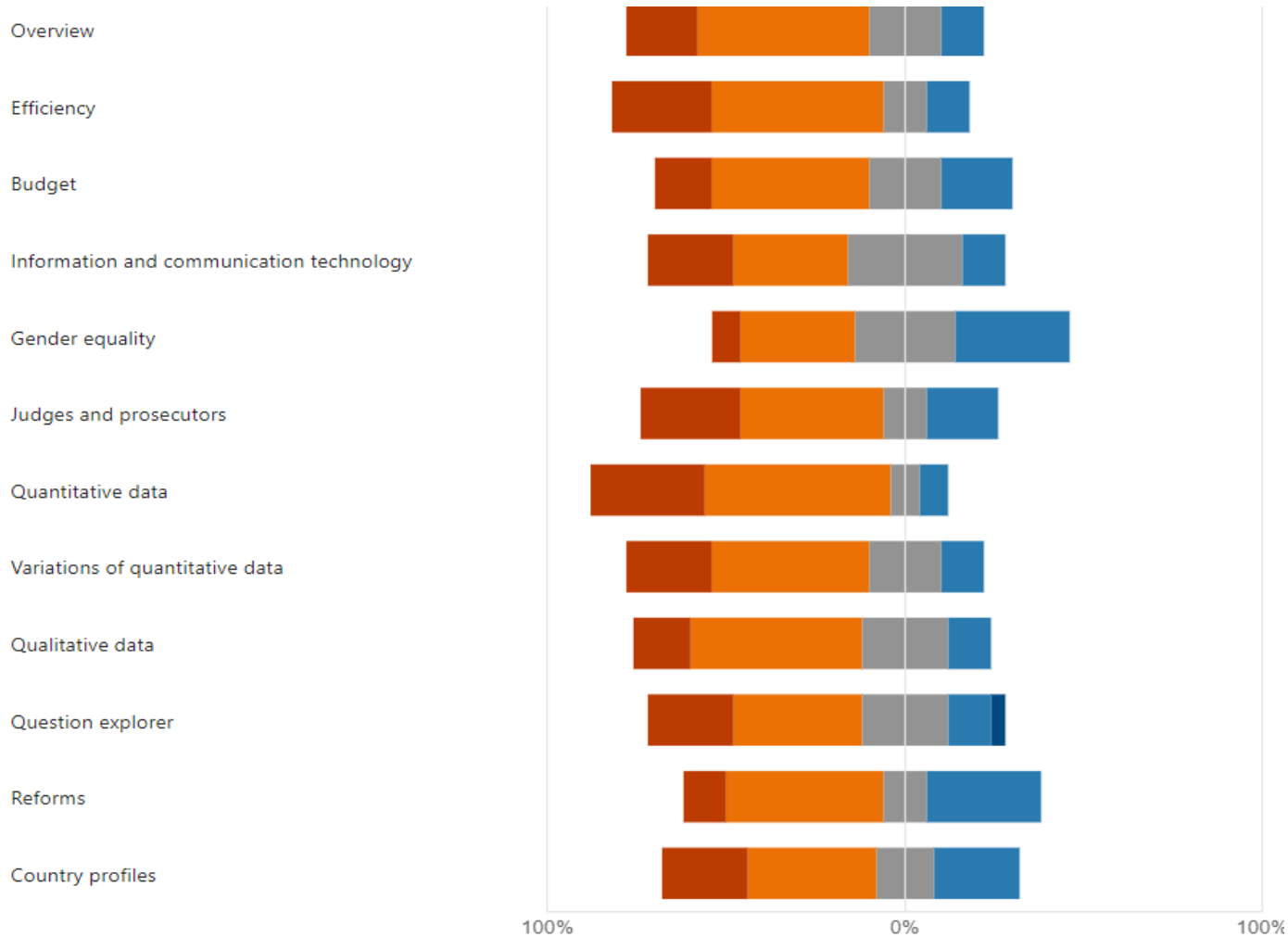

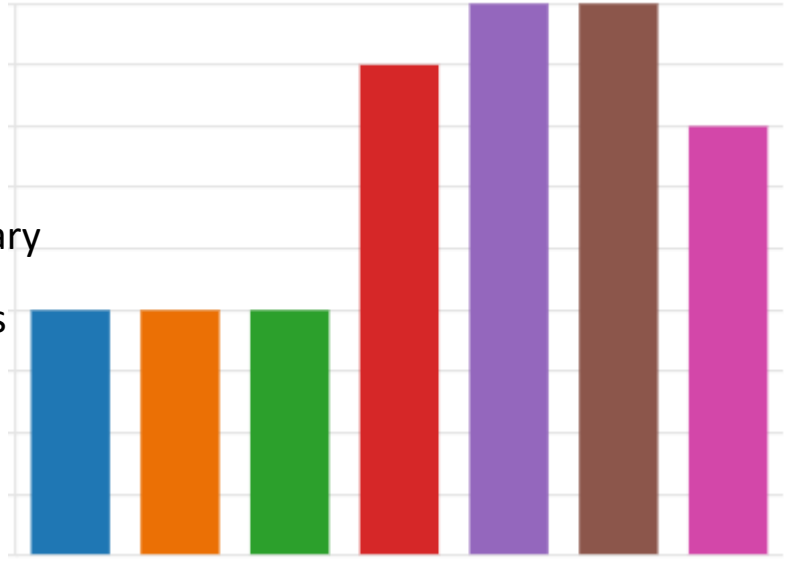
Frequency of use of CEPEJ-STAT

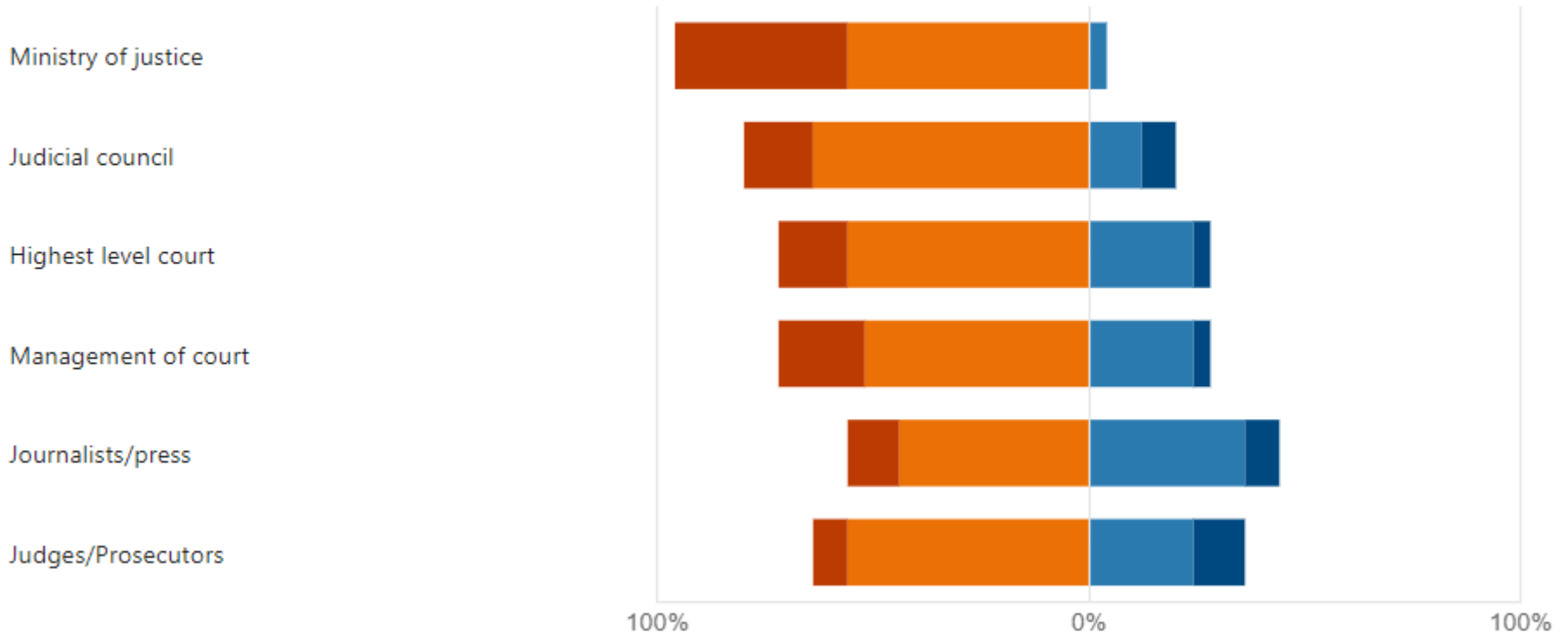
Dissemination of the CEPEJ Report in the member states
