The Eurimages Board of Management adopted guidelines for the granting of the Fund's sponsorship and patronage. This document will be published on the Eurimages website in the coming days. The Eurimages Fund renewed its partnership with the Seville Festival for its next edition which will take place from 9-11 November 2018: the Eurimages Prize will be awarded to a co-production supported by the Fund selected in one of the different sections of the Festival. Finally, the Board of Management decided to authorise organisers of events in which Eurimages takes part to use the Eurimages logo in their promotional material.
