Referring to your letter of 18 January I would like to, on behalf of the Swedish Government (the Government), submit the following comments on Sweden's non-accepted provisions of the European Social Charter (the Charter).

The Government's position on the relevant provisions 2.1, 2.2, 2.4, 2.7, 3.4, 4.2, 4.5, 7.5, 7.6, 8.2, 8.4, 8.5, 12.4, 24 and 28, remains the same as in the previous overviews. The rationales for this position have not changed and are in principle the same as mentioned in the official reports of 2018, 2014 and 2008 (enclosed).

The Government wishes to take this opportunity to reiterate its respect for the rights enshrined by the Charter and to express its intention to continuously respect and to be in conformity with the Charter.
