<p>Where provided by the national law, duration of each obligation imposed</p>	<p>If necessary to reduce the risk of the person under supervision committing new crimes or to otherwise facilitate his or her adaptation to society, the Swedish Prison and Probation Service may decide on a special regulation to be followed by the person under supervision. Such a regulation shall be decided for a certain period of time, not exceeding one year at a time.</p> <p>If necessary to verify compliance with an obligation, the Prison and Probation Service may decide on electronic monitoring. Electronic monitoring may be decided for a maximum of six months at a time.</p>

¹ This obligation does not include the supervision of compliance with any professional disqualifications imposed on the person as part of the sanction applied to the offender

Duration of the total probation period (if different from the duration mentioned above)	<p>After conditional release, a probation period applies that corresponds to the remaining sentence at the time of release, but at least two years.</p> <p>A conditional sentence entails a probationary period of two years.</p> <p>A probation sentence (alternative sanction) entails a probationary period of three years from the date on which the penalty begins to be enforced.</p>
