 - Origin/DG Remarks The European Committee of Social Rights is established by the European Social Charter. It is composed of 15 independent experts. It works on two specific objectives: treating collective complaints and examining national reports on the application of the European Social Charter with a view to rule on the conformity of national situations under the Charter.
 - **Objective(s)** To examine the pending collective complaints;
 - To examine national reports for Conclusions XXII-3 (2022) of the 1961 Charter and Conclusions 2022 of the Revised Charter;
 - To examine developments relating to the procedure on non-accepted provisions;
 - To resume the discussion on strengthening the Council of Europe's social rights framework
 - To examine possible amendments to the Committee's Rules
