To the Members of the Bureau of the Assembly

Synopsis

of the meeting held in The Hague on 2 March 2023

The Bureau of the Assembly, meeting on Thursday 2 March 2023, in The Hague, with Mr Tiny Kox, President of the Parliamentary Assembly, in the Chair, as regards:

- **Communications:** took note of the communications by the President of the Assembly, the Secretary General and the Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe;
- **Standing Committee in The Hague (2-3 March 2023)**
 - Request for a current affairs debate: took note of the request to hold a debate on “Supporting Ukraine one year since the beginning of the Russian Federation’s large-scale war of aggression: the role of the Council of Europe”, decided to recommend to the Standing Committee to hold this debate and appointed Mr Iulian Bulai (Romania, ALDE) as the first speaker;
 - Draft agenda: updated the draft agenda;
- **Second part-session of 2023 (Strasbourg, 24-28 April):** decided to start the Plenary sittings at 2:30 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, asked the President to consider convening a meeting of the Joint Committee, took note of the request by the leaders of the political groups for the Assembly to hold a current affairs debate on “On the #RoadToReykjavik”, and drew-up the draft agenda;
- **Standing Committee in Reykjavik (15 May 2023):** took note of the draft agenda;
- **References and transmissions to committees:** approved the references and transmissions as set out in Appendix 1, subject to ratification by the Standing Committee;
- **Elections observation**
 - Montenegro: Presidential election (19 March 2023): confirmed the appointment of Mr Joe O’Reilly (Ireland, EPP/CD) as Chairperson, approved the final list of members of the ad hoc committee (appendix 2) and took note of the statement by the pre-electoral mission;
 - Bulgaria: parliamentary elections (2 April 2023): approved the list of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections and appointed Mr Andrej Hunko (Germany, UEL) as Chairperson (appendix 3);

- Türkiye: Presidential and parliamentary elections (14 May 2023, tbc): approved the list of members of the ad hoc committee to observe these elections, appointed Mr Frank Schwabe (Germany, SOC) as Chairperson (appendix 4) and decided that the same delegation would observe the second round of these elections;
- Conference “Elections in times of crisis: challenges and opportunities” (Bern, 9-10 May 2023): decided to include the institutional representatives of the Assembly to the Council for Democratic Elections as *ex officio* members, as well as to allocate a seat to a member not belonging to a political group to the ad hoc committee to participate in the conference, approved the list of members of this ad hoc committee and appointed Mr Damien Cottier (Switzerland, ALDE) as Chairperson (appendix 5);
- Annual meeting on Election Observation: took note of the report;
- **Václav Havel Human Rights Prize:** took note of the memorandum prepared by the Secretary General of the Assembly and re-appointed as members of the Selection Panel Ms Anne Brasseur and Mr Nils Muižnieks for a third term of two years starting from 1 June 2023;
- **Institutional representation of the Parliamentary Assembly in 2023:** following a consultation by written procedure, approved on 15 February 2023 the nominations as set up in Appendix 6;
- **Participation of members in Parliamentary Assembly plenary sessions and committee meetings:** took note of the information memorandum on the participation of members in Parliamentary Assembly plenary sessions and committee meetings in 2022 in accordance with Resolution 1583 (2007) and decided:
 - to invite the President of the Assembly to address letters to the chairpersons of the delegations and the speakers of the parliaments concerned by low participation rates,
 - to publish the statistics relating to the participation of national delegations on the Assembly’s website;
- **Composition of the Monitoring Committee:** on the basis of proposals by
 - the SOC Group, nominated Ms Kate OSAMOR (United Kingdom) as a member;
 - the EPP/CD Group, nominated Ms Zanda KALNINA-LUKASEVICA (Latvia) and Ms Denitsa SACHEVA (Bulgaria) as members,
- **Meetings elsewhere than Strasbourg or Paris:**
 - authorised:
 - the Committee on Equality and Non-Discrimination and the Parliamentary Network Women Free from Violence, to meet in Marrakech, Morocco, on 8-9 June 2023;
 - the Monitoring Committee, to hold a meeting in Rome on 30-31 May 2023 (subject to receiving an invitation);
 - taking into account security concerns, postponed the decision concerning the request by the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights for its ad hoc sub-committee to meet in Ukraine, until the Committee is in a position to define the exact dates and places of the meeting;
- **Dates and place of next meetings:**
 - Monday 24 April 2023, 8 am, Strasbourg (part-session)
 - Friday 28 April 2023, 8 am (part-session)
