Origin/DG Remarks The European Committee of Social Rights is established by the European Social Charter. It is composed of 15 independent experts. It works on 2 specific objectives: treating collective complaints and examining national reports on the application of the European Social Charter with a view to rule on the conformity of national situations under the Charter.

Objective(s) - to welcome the new member of the Committee and hear her solemn declaration;

- to examine:

- the pending collective complaints;
- developments relating to the procedure on non-accepted provisions including the draft second report on the provisions not accepted by Bosnia and Herzegovina;

- to hold a discussion on the provisions for Conclusions 2019/XXI-4 and to agree general guidelines for the drafting of the conclusions.

Output

- 1) The new member, Tatiana PUIU, made the solemn declaration and took up her duty in the Committee
- 2) The Rapporteurs for the pending collective complaints informed the Committee of the progress of the proceedings and the President informed about the procedural decisions taken since the previous session (Rules 27 and 28) as well as about new complaints registered;
- 3) The Committee adopted a decision on admissibility in:
 - Sindacato Autonomo Europeo Scuola ed Ecologia (SAESE) v. Italy
Complaint No.166/2018

- Associazione nazionale sindacato professionisti sanitari della funzione infermieristica - Nursing Up v. Italy
Complaint No.169/2018
- 4) The Committee adopted the second report on the non-accepted provisions in respect of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The Committee was informed of the latest developments with respect to the procedure on non-accepted provisions;
- 5) The Committee held a discussion on the provisions for Conclusions 2019/XXI-4 and agreed general guidelines for the drafting of the conclusions.

Conclusions/Follow Up The Committee instructed the Secretariat:

- to notify the decisions regarding collective complaints according to the usual procedure;
- to follow the collective complaints procedure with the Rapporteurs for the pending complaints;
- to finalise the report on non-accepted provisions in respect of Bosnia and Herzegovina with a view to notifying it to the relevant authorities as soon as possible;
- to remain in contact with the other States Parties concerned on the procedure on non-accepted provisions.
