Synopsis of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 23, 24 and 25 January 2024

The **Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media**, meeting in Strasbourg on Tuesday 23 January 2024 from 8.30 am to 9.30 am, Wednesday 24 January 2024, from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm, and on Thursday 25 January 2024 from 8.30 am to 9.45 am, with Lord George Foulkes (United Kingdom, SOC), the oldest member present, Ms Fiona O'Loughlin (Ireland, ALDE), 1st Vice-Chairperson, then Mr Birgir Thórarinsson (Iceland, EPP/CD), 2nd Vice-Chairperson, in the chair,

Tuesday, 23 January from 8.30 am to 9.30 am, as regards:

- **Election of the Bureau of the committee**: elected by acclamation:

 - Mr Mogens Jensen (Denmark, SOC) as General Rapporteur on Governance and Ethics in Sport and heard his declaration of absence of conflict of interests;
- **Assembly's institutional representation**: designated, for their appointment by the Bureau of the Assembly, the following representatives to the:
