Synopsis

of the meeting held in Strasbourg on 24, 25, 26 and 27 June 2024

The Committee on the Honouring of Obligations and Commitments by Member States of the Council of Europe (Monitoring Committee), meeting in Strasbourg on 24, 25, 26 and 27 June 2024 partly in camera, with Mr Mogens Jensen (Denmark, SOC) and Ms Zanda Kalniṇa-Lukaševica (Latvia, EPP/CD) in the Chair:

- on Monday, 24 June 2024 at 14:00, as regards:
- Exchange of views with the Commissioner for Human Rights of the Council of Europe: heard a statement by Mr Michael O'Flaherty, Commissioner for Human Rights of the Council of Europe and held an exchange of views:
- Challenges to democracy in Georgia (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Claude Kern, France, ALDE and Ms Edite Estrela, Portugal, SOC): confirmed the appointment of Mr Claude Kern (France, ALDE) and Ms Edite Estrela (Portugal, SOC) as co-rapporteurs and held an exchange of views;
- The honouring of obligations and commitments by Türkiye (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Stefan Schennach, Austria, SOC and Ms Jill Mortimer, United Kingdom, EC/DA): heard an oral report by the co-rapporteur, Mr Stefan Schennach (Austria, SOC), on his fact-finding visit to Türkiye (11-14 June 2024) and held an exchange of views;
- on Tuesday, 25 June 2024 at 08:30, as regards:
- Challenges to democracy in Georgia (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Claude Kern, France, ALDE and Ms Edite Estrela, Portugal, SOC): considered a draft report and adopted unanimously a draft resolution;
- **Post-monitoring dialogue with Bulgaria** (Co-rapporteurs: Ms Thórhildur Sunna Ævarsdóttir, Iceland, SOC and Ms Deborah Bergamini, Italy, EPP/CD): heard a statement by Mr Oleksii Goncharenko (Ukraine, EC/DA), Chairperson of the ad hoc Committee for the observation of the early parliamentary elections in Bulgaria (9 June 2024), and held an exchange of views;
- on Tuesday, 25 June 2024 at 14:00, as regards:
- Strengthening mechanisms for early warning on challenges to democratic security: held a joint hearing with the Committee on Political Affairs and Democracy, with the participation of Ambassador Svetlana Geleva, Permanent Representative of North Macedonia, Chairperson of GR-DEM and Dr Seema Shah, Head of Programme, Democracy Assessment, International Institute for Democracy and Electoral Assistance (International IDEA) (online);

- on Wednesday, 26 June 2024 at 14:00, as regards:
- The honouring of obligations and commitments by Armenia (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Kimmo Kiljunen, Finland, SOC and Ms Boriana Åberg, Sweden, EPP/CD): took position on two written amendments tabled to the draft resolution and took note of the rapporteur`s intention to propose one oral amendment on behalf of the Committee;
- **Challenges to democracy in Georgia** (Co-rapporteurs: Mr Claude Kern, France, ALDE and Ms Edite Estrela, Portugal, SOC): took position on five amendments tabled to the draft resolution;
- The honouring of membership obligations to the Council of Europe by Greece (periodic monitoring report) (Co-rapporteurs: Ms Laura Castel, Spain, UEL and...): postponed the appointment of a co-rapporteur until its next meeting;
- **Post-monitoring dialogue with Albania** (Co-rapporteurs:): postponed the appointment of co-rapporteurs until its next meeting;
- World Forum for Democracy on "Democracy and Diversity Can we transcend the divides?" (Strasbourg, 6-8 November 2024): took note of the concept note and nominated Mr Serhii Soboliev (Ukraine, EPP/CD) and Ms Valentina Grippo (Italy, ALDE) to sit on the ad hoc Committee of the Bureau of the Assembly to participate in this Forum;
- European Holocaust Memorial Day for Roma and Sinti (Auschwitz-Birkenau, Poland, 2 August 2024): took note of the programme and made a call for candidates to be appointed to the ad hoc Committee of the Bureau of the Assembly to participate in this event;
- **Authorisation of fact-finding visits:** authorised the co-rapporteurs for Bulgaria, Georgia, Montenegro, Netherlands, North Macedonia, Serbia, Spain and Sweden to conduct a fact-finding visit to the countries under their respective responsibilities, subject to the availability of financial resources;
- Next meetings: confirmed its next meetings as follows:
 - o Paris, 11 September 2024
 - o Strasbourg, 30 September-4 October 2024 [during the Assembly part-session]
 - o Tirana, 2-3 December 2024
- on Thursday, 27 June 2024 at 08:45, as regards:
- Regulating foreign influence: best practices and European standards: held a joint hearing with the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights, with the participation of Ms Veronika Bílková, Vice-President of the European Commission for Democracy through Law (Venice Commission) and Ms Tanya Lokshina, Associate Director, Europe and Central Asia Division, Human Rights Watch.
