Cyberviolence

To collect information on domestic criminal legislation and policies in relation to cyberviolence with a view to:

- assisting current and future Parties to the Convention on Cybercrime intending to address offences related to cyberviolence in their domestic law;
- updating the Council of Europe's online [Cyberviolence Resource](#).

The purpose: **not to** assess Parties to the Convention in terms of measures taken regarding cyberviolence.

- Useful exercise for reviewing and comparing domestic approaches to addressing cyberviolence offences.
