The Bureau took note of the information provided by the Chair, notably in relation to her exchange with the GR-J on 7 December 2021.

- Item 5 **Convention 108+ State of play**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the Secretariat on the signatures and ratifications of the Protocol amending Convention 108 (CETS No. 223, hereafter Convention 108+): 43 signatures out of which, 15 ratifications. Since the November plenary meeting, the Secretariat has been informed that Armenia had completed the internal ratification process of the Amending Protocol CETS No. 223.

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the Secretariat on the latest developments regarding Costa Rica's request for accession with a view to finalising the opinion for adoption by the Committee, including by written procedure.
- Item 6 **Evaluation and review mechanism under Convention 108+**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the Secretariat on the draft "rules of Procedure for the Evaluation and review mechanism under Convention 108+", held an exchange of views and instructed the Secretariat to gather comments on the text by 11 February 2022 to be discussed at next meetings.
- Item 7 **Digital identity**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the expert on the state of play of the Draft Guidelines on digital identity and instructed the Secretariat to further amend the document, send it early January for comments by 11 February, and prepare the document for discussion at next meetings.
- Item 8 **Inter-state exchanges of data for Anti-Money Laundering/Countering Financing of Terrorism, and tax purposes**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the rapporteur and the Secretariat on the Outline of the Draft guidelines on the implications for data protection of mechanisms for inter-state exchanges of data for Anti-Money Laundering/Countering Financing of Terrorism, and tax purposes, held an exchange of views, and instructed the Secretariat, under the guidance of the Rapporteur, to insert comments, circulate the text for further comments to be received by 11 February, including on the scope of the document and prepare the document for discussion at next meetings.
- Item 9 **Interpretation of Article 11 of the modernised Convention 108**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the rapporteur and the Secretariat, held an exchange of views and instructed the Secretariat, under the guidance of the Rapporteur, to draft the substantial document, with the assistance of high-level experts, for discussion at next meetings.
- Item 10 **Contractual clauses in the context of transborder data flows**
The Bureau took note of the information provided by the rapporteur and the expert, held an exchange of views and instructed the Secretariat, under the guidance of the Rapporteur, to prepare a draft revised and updated Model contract to be sent early January for comments by 11 February, and discussion at next meetings.

It also took note of the information provided by the Steering Committee on Media and Information Society (CDMSI), notably regarding the approval of the *draft Recommendation of the Committee of Ministers to member States on the impacts of digital technologies on freedom of expression*, prepared by the [Committee of Experts on Freedom of Expression and Digital Technologies \(MSI-DIG\)](#) and for which an Opinion of the T-PD Bureau had been issued.

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the President of the Authority for Personal Data Protection of the Republic of Benin, recently invited by the T-PD to take part in its work under article 4 bis of the Rules of Procedure.
