Item 5 Convention 108+ state of play

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and Bureau and T-PD members on signatures and ratifications of the Protocol amending Convention 108 (CETS No. 223, hereafter Convention 108+): 43 signatures out of which, 20 ratifications. Since the November Plenary, Argentina, France and Senegal have completed their internal ratification procedures. The Bureau decided to hold another tour de table at the next plenary meeting in June 2023.

As regards Costa Rica, the Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and Bureau members on the latest state of play of the internal procedure in Costa Rica.

Item 6 Digital identity

The Bureau took note of the publication of the Guidelines on National Digital Identity on the website. Paper publication will follow next year.

Item 7 Data protection for the processing of personal data for Anti-Money Laundering / Countering Financing of Terrorism purposes

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat on the latest draft document following the 43rd Plenary meeting and held an exchange of views. As a reminder, the draft text has been sent for comments to be provided by Thursday 2 February 2023 for discussion at the 58th Bureau meeting.

Item 8 Interpretation of Article 11 of the modernised Convention 108

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and held an exchange of views regarding the on-going drafting work based on doc T-PD(2021)7 and the next meeting of the Working Group on Article 11 ('GT-Article 11') on 27-28 February 2023.

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the rapporteur and the secretariat on the latest draft document following the 43rd Plenary meeting and held an exchange of views. It also decided to hold discussions at the next plenary in relation to Article 17 of Convention 108+ with a view to exchanging on forms of cooperation in this respect.

Item 16 Observers

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and held an exchange of views on the state of play of the observer status and potential future requests.

Item 17 Any Other Business

The secretariat reminded the Bureau that the call for candidates for a secondment of a programme manager at the Data Protection Unit, Information Society Department, DGI, has been extended to 15 January 2023 and encouraged the participants to disseminate it widely. It also informed the Bureau that an assistant has been temporary recruited until the completion of the relevant competition in 2023.
