### Item 5 Convention 108+ state of play

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat on signatures and ratifications of the Protocol amending Convention 108 (CETS No. 223, hereafter Convention 108+): 44 signatures, out of which 21 ratifications. Since the 57<sup>th</sup> Bureau meeting in December 2022, Iceland has ratified amending Protocol CETS No. 223, and Moldova signed it. As a reminder, the 57<sup>th</sup> Bureau had decided to hold another tour de table at the next plenary meeting in June 2023.

As regards Costa Rica, the Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and Bureau members on the latest state of play of the internal procedure in Costa Rica.

# Item 6 Data protection for the processing of personal data for anti-money laundering / countering financing of terrorism purposes

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat on the latest draft document, held an exchange of views and agreed on further amending the text and instructed the secretariat, under the guidance of the rapporteur, to gather written comments on the amended text for discussion and finalisation at the June plenary meeting.

### Item 7 Model contractual clauses for the transfer of personal data

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the rapporteur and the secretariat on the latest draft document, held an exchange of views, agreed on further amending the text and instructed the secretariat, under the guidance of the rapporteur, to gather written comments on the amended text for discussion and finalisation at the June plenary meeting.

### Item 8 Interpretation of Article 11 of the modernised Convention 108

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and held an exchange of views regarding the on-going drafting work based on doc T-PD(2021)7 and the meeting of the Working Group on Article 11 ('GT-Article 11') on 27-28 February 2023. The Bureau instructed the secretariat to continue developing T-PD(2021)7 with the assistance of the GT-Article 11, for discussion at the next plenary meeting.

### Item 9 Data Protection, including biometrics, within the framework of vote and elections

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and the expert, held an exchange of views and instructed the Secretariat to prepare, with the assistance of the expert, a first draft for discussion at the 44<sup>th</sup> T-PD plenary meeting on 14-16 June 2023.

### Item 10 Cooperation with other Council of Europe bodies and entities

The Bureau took note of the information provided by the secretariat and Bureau members, notably as to the latest state of play in the CAI and the drafting of the future instrument.

### Item 11 Major developments and activities in the field of data protection

The Bureau took note of the information provided by Bureau members and the secretariat. The secretariat informed the Bureau on the forthcoming second edition of the Privacy Symposium, in Venice (17-21 April), of which the first day will be entirely dedicated to the promotion of Convention 108+. The secretariat draws the attention of the participants to the Bureau meeting, on the importance of reporting on the participation of members in other international data protection fora with a view to encouraging closer cooperation with these fora, and to promoting Convention 108/108+ and T-PD's work there.

The Bureau took note of the dates of the next plenary meetings to be held on 14-16 June 2023 and 15-17 November 2023, as well as of the next Bureau meetings on 27-29 September 2023 and 12-14 December 2023.
