## SPECIFIC TASK

Under the supervision of the Gender Equality Commission (GEC), the Drafting Committee is entrusted with the task of drafting a recommendation to prevent and combat sexism and to submit it to the GEC for approval prior to its transmission to the Committee of Ministers for consideration and eventual adoption.

## Composition

## Members:

All member States shall be entitled to appoint a representative with relevant expertise. The Council of Europe will bear the travel and subsistence expenses of one representative from 15 member States (Andorra, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Croatia, Denmark, Estonia, France, Germany, Malta, Montenegro, Russian Federation, Slovenia, Spain, United Kingdom).

Member States may send additional representatives, without the right to vote and without defrayal of expenses, to the meetings of the Drafting Committee.

## Participants:

The following may send a representative, without the right to vote and at the charge of their corresponding administrative budgets:

- Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe;
- Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe;
- Conference of INGOs of the Council of Europe,
- Committees or other bodies of the Council of Europe engaged in related work, as appropriate.

The following may send representatives, without the right to vote and without defrayal of expenses:

> - All participants and observers to the Gender Equality Commission.
