


The Ambulance for Monuments activity: Community involvement

- Project for safeguarding the built heritage, initiated in 2016 by the MONUMENTUM Association.
- In recent years, the "Ambulance for Monuments" project has expanded, being currently managed by a number of organizations, existing or newly created, with independent activity in several regions of Romania.



The objectives of the Ambulance for Monuments are:



- To get the communities involved in sustainable heritage safeguarding actions
- To safeguard the immovable heritage and keep a record of such heritage
- To increase the level of professional training of the experts through non-formal and informal participatory education based on the "hands on training system"
- To recover the traditional techniques and the local materials
- To increase the philanthropy level and create new audiences for such heritage.



The Ambulance for Monuments How does it work?

- Communities provide materials, accommodation and meals for coordinators, craftsmen and volunteers.
- The Ambulance for Monuments provides the tools and labor: craftsmen and volunteers, helps to prepare the necessary documentation.


