



CoE HELP = Council of Europe Programme for Human Rights Education for Legal Professionals

HELP's goal:

To HELP legal (and other) professionals apply European human rights standards in their daily work, mainly by training





Key documents

- CM Recommendation Rec (2004) 4 on the **ECHR in** university education and professional training—birth certificate of HELP!
- Brighton Declaration of April 2012 effective implementation of the ECHR at the national level by "providing appropriate information and training about the Convention in the study, training and professional development of judges, lawyers and prosecutors".
- PACE Recommendation 2039 (2014) on the need to reinforce the training of legal professionals on the ECHR called for the reinforcement of HELP
- Brussels Declaration of March 2015 increase efforts at national level to raise awareness... on the Convention, ...including by having recourse to the HELP Programme
