The Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe adopted Recommendation CM/Rec(2022)16 to provide a comprehensive, multi-stakeholder approach for preventing and combating hate speech.

The primary objective of this compilation is to draw attention to a wide range of promising practices by member States and other key stakeholders consistent with the Recommendation during its early implementation period. By distilling key insights and strategies from this emergent body of experience, the compilation offers concrete and practical guidance for the further development of good practices fulfilling the aims and objectives of CM/Rec(2022)16.
