Effects at international and national levels

Vienna Convention on the Law on Treaties (1969)

National Constitutions

- Entry into force (art. 24)
- Signature / Ratification (artt. 9-17)
- Changes in domestic legal systems – self-executing/non-self-executing provisions
- ...

Quid of the implementation?

- right/duties to cultural heritage
- recognition of heritage communities
- cooperation and participatory processes
-

art. 6 (c) Faro Convention



Alleged violations of the right to CH?

- Right to CH already recognized into the domestic legal system – the domestic judge will assess and decide on the potential violation (at national and local level)
- The right to CH is part of art. 15 of the ICESCR - communications brought before the CESCR ? (Optional Protocol to ICESCR) by:
 - Individuals/HC (art.2 Optional Protocol)
 - Other states (art. 10 Optional Protocol)
- Communication to the Steering Committee for Culture, Heritage and Landscape (CDCPP)?
- Social sanctions



Alleged nonobservance of Faro provisions?

- Communication – request to give an advisory opinion (art.16b) to the Steering Committee for Culture, Heritage and Landscape (CDCPP)?
- Social sanctions – by individuals/ HCs and other States Parties
