1. Opening of the webinar by the Secretariat

Mr Mikaël Poutiers, Secretary of the Bern Convention, opened the webinar, welcoming participants.

He highlighted that some gaps and lack of data were identified in the previous reporting under Resolution No. 8 (2012) of the Bern Standing Committee. After analysis of the data gaps, experts detected that most of them reflected the difficulty to interpret difficult concepts such as FRV, habitats condition and future trends. In fact, many countries didn't have a clear view of what was expected from them. The webinar was therefore organised to help participants in this exercise, and share practical views from countries with more experience.

2. Favourable Reference Values

As a general introduction to the issue, Mr Otars Opermanis, Independent Expert, informed participants of the concept of Favourable Reference Values (FRV): theory, observations and examples from Latvia to illustrate a reference-based approach, a mode-based approach and an alternative approach for species.
