

Turkey: Degradation of nesting beaches in Fethiye & Patara Specially Protected Areas

HIM

Fethiye & Patara are among most important sea turtle nesting beaches in Turkey



Recommendation No. 182

- **No. 1:** Patara nesting beach receives appropriate legal protection & management \rightarrow **No improvement**
- **No. 2:** Define fines for non-compliance \rightarrow **No Action**
- **No. 3:** Ensure adequate financial & human resources for control, management & enforcement of regulations
- \rightarrow No management personnel on site to enforce regulations, measures not enforced
- **No. 8.** Set up long-term conservation & research programme with permanent team & adequate manpower for entire beach & season \rightarrow **One-season contract, inadequate manpower**



Patara Rec. 182 No. 2: Prohibit development on beach, remove abandoned illegal facilities & restore dunes



Abandoned SPA facilities have not been removed from the dunes



Patara Rec. 182. 2: Regulate extent & use of beach furniture, ensure removal from nesting zone at night No zoning in 90% of Patara SPA nesting beach



Incorrect & inadequate zoning in Patara main beach: 2 old posts mark sunbed use area.



Umbrellas are inserted randomly on nesting beach

Patara Rec. 182. 2: Regulate extent & use of beach furniture, ensure removal from nesting zone at night





Volleyball court remains on nesting beach, is a threat to nests

Walkways & tents are permanent obstacles for turtles



Patara Rec. 182. 2: Prohibit access of vehicles by placing barriers at beach entrances



Entire beach flattened mechanically (north end)



Uncontrolled vehicle access. No guards, no barriers. Quads, motorbikes, tractors and 4x4 vehicles on entire nesting beach.



Patara Rec. 182. 2: Prohibit access of vehicles by placing barriers at beach entrances








No guards, no sign, no barriers. Entry point via dunes (near summer house village) is busier, more litter, more human presence at night

Patara Rec. 182. 2: Prohibit illumination of beach



Hatchling disorientation due to lights from new summer house village.

Camping lights & two street lamps also affect beach.



Patara Rec. 182. 2: Prohibit camping on beach & riversides in view of beach



Human presence, lights, vehicles and bonfires at night, on mouth of Esen river, in view of nesting beach



Patara Rec. 182. 5: Ensure litter is periodically removed from beach & dunes



Visitors use nest cages as bins, indicating lack of awareness. Litter also observed on beaches around Esen river (due to camping).



Patara Recommendation No. 182

9: Tourists: Improve information & awareness
-> No substantial action (2 signs, 1 info point twice per week)
10: Local community: Improve information & education,
involve in conservation & management - > No action



Information kiosk irregularly in operation

Only 2 information signs along the 12km beach

Patara Rec. 182. 4: Continue to prevent uncontrolled human settlement behind the beach

300-312 summer houses 120% population increase

Inside SPA in 3rd Degree Archaeological Site >800 m from sand dunes >1500 m from beach



Blue line: 3rd Degree Archaeological Site. Yellow line: 1st Degree Archaeological Site

Patara Rec. 182. 4: Continue to prevent uncontrolled human settlement behind the beach

Construction continues for a total of 310 buildings

Patara Recommendation No. 182

2: Prohibit horse riding, 4x4 safaris on beach -> not effectively addressed, no improvement

2: Prohibit fishing with nets in front of beach -> no observation

6: Address the problem of predation -> not effectively addressed, no improvement (most nests not protected)

7: Ensure proper fencing of nests in areas with high human presence -> not effectively addressed, no improvement (50% of nests were not caged)

Recommendation NOT fully implemented





<u>Fethiye Rec. 183. 1</u>: Stop further development of permanent structures (buildings, shipyard, jetties, etc.)



New business on severely degraded nesting beach. Nesting zone further occupied & disturbances increased.

<u>Fethiye Rec. 183. 1</u>: Stop further development of permanent structures (buildings, shipyard, jetties, etc.)

2 new jetties & cordoned sea areas, occupy nesting beach, increase marine traffic (5 jetties in protected area)







<u>Fethiye Rec. 183. 1</u>: Stop further development of permanent structures (buildings, shipyard, jetties, etc.)



Wetland burnt and flattened (red circle) next to the 2015 Barut TUI Sensatori Resort. New resort planned?



Fethiye Rec. 183. 2: Remove structures & restore sandy areas



Concrete platforms, carpets & volleyball courts permanently occupy nesting beach







Fethiye Rec. 183. 2: Remove structures & restore sandy areas



More tables, umbrellas, permanent shades, camping tents, showers, playgrounds, pavilions, etc. on the nesting beach

Fethiye Rec. 183. 2: Remove structures & restore sandy areas



New huge shaded water sports tent on nesting beach.

Showers cabins remain on beach with water leaking



vegetation due to water runoff

Carpets, tables & watersport equipment on nesting beach day & night







TUI Resort - Several pavilions, 2 sunbed rows, 2 walkways and a water sport tent remain inside the nesting zone.



<u>Fethiye Rec. 183. 5</u>: Map & zone the whole Fethiye coast. Enforce beach furniture night removal/stacking

Businesses completely occupy nesting zone with dense rows of sunbeds that are not removed at night.

Note nests in red circles.









<u>Fethiye Rec. 183. 5</u>: Map & zone the whole Fethiye coast. Enforce beach furniture night removal/stacking



There was an <u>increase</u> in walkways & beach furniture that were <u>not collected</u> at night on 80% of beach



Fethiye Rec. 183. 6: Prohibit furniture, structures or facilities on the sandy zones of Akgöl beach



Fethiye Rec. 183. 3: Stop sand extraction

Sand movement with heavy machinery during nesting season

Sand extraction next to Barut TUI Sensatori Resort







Fethiye Rec. 183. 4: Remove planted vegetation





New acacia trees, palms & lawn planted & watered on the nesting beaches




Fethiye Rec. 183. 7: Reduce light pollution





Light pollution is severe. Businesses host wedding parties on nesting beach at night



Fethiye Rec. 183. 8: Build permanent road barriers, designate parking & picnic areas away from beach

Due to lack of barriers, vehicles drove on most of the nesting beaches.







Fethiye Rec. 183. 11: Prohibit camping & bonfires, set appropriate time limits for beach bars operation at night

Camping, picnics & bonfires observed on all nesting beaches.

No time restrictions for operation of beach businesses







Fethiye Rec. 183. 15: Improve information (communication of regulations, signs, guest campaigns, business & community involvement)

No signs or no legible signs on approx. 6.5 km of nesting beach.





Fethiye Recommendation 183

9: Regulate maritime traffic, prohibit at appropriate distances, set speed limits & mark corridors -> No Action

10. Set up long-term research & conservation programs, with adequate manpower. Assess: (i) photo-pollution effects (ii) disturbance of nesting females (iii) predation

-> No Action, one-season project

12: Clean beach & ensure sewage is not discharged into sea -> Litter not collected on 6.5 of 8 km beach (see report photos)

13. Set up & enforce adequate regulations and fines-> No Action

14. Ensure adequate financial & human resources for control
 & management -> No Action

16. Protect all nests with cages -> predation is still



URGENT ACTION NEEDED

to protect Fethiye & Patara's natural & cultural heritage

Majority of measures under Recommendations 182 & 183 (2015) NOT implemented

We call upon the Standing Committee to:

- Keep the case file <u>open</u>
- Urge Turkish authorities to implement all measures under Recommendations 182 & 183 with no further delay, before May 2019
