

Questions and Answers. Grants for awareness raising on the Council of Europe Gender Equality Strategy by civil society organisations in Ukraine

<p>Is the deadline 7th June?</p>	<p>Yes, the deadline for submissions is 7 June. There was a mistake in the call for proposals. We apologise for this inconvenience.</p>
<p>We do not have a background in implementing gender-focused projects, I am wondering if it is still worth applying for the grant. Will our lack of experience in gender-specific projects affect our eligibility?</p>	<p>One of our eligibility criteria is have been active for at least 3 (three) years in the field of gender equality and gender mainstreaming. In order to be eligible for our grants you need to have experience in the field of gender equality and gender mainstreaming.</p>
<p>We would like to confirm whether any % of the grant could be used on capital expenditure such as the purchase and installation of street lighting with an aim of increasing safety of women and girls during evening hours.</p>	<p>This type of expenditure is not foreseen under our project's grants.</p>
<p>Do all consortium parties need to be registered to operate in Ukraine? One of the parties of a possible consortium is a self-employed individual (consultant) who's a dual Canadian-Ukrainian citizen. Also, does a beneficiary need to sign the grant agreement if it provides in-kind contributions?</p>	<p>1.Our eligibility criteria says that be the grantee must be legally constituted as a non-governmental organisation in Ukraine and be entitled to carry out in Ukraine activities described in its project proposal. Also, please note that dual citizenship is illegal in Ukraine. 2.All grantees must sign a grant agreement.</p>
<p>Can you fill in the application form in Ukrainian?</p>	<p>All documents shall be submitted in English (with exception of organisation's registration certificate and statute, income and expenditure statement for the year of 2023), failure to do so will result in the exclusion of the Grantee.</p>
<p>The amount of co-financing must be at least 10%. Please specify the amount of the 10% bill. From the amount of the grant from the Council of Europe (15,000 *10% = 1,500 euros, the grantee must additionally invest. Then the total amount of the project will be 16,500 euros).</p>	<p>The grantee shall contribute to the action or the project either by way of its own resources or by contribution from third parties. Co-financing may take the form of financial or human resources, in-kind contributions or income generated by the action or project. According to our call for proposals it should be at least 10%. It should be 10% of the project's budget. So, if 15000 EUR is 90% of the budget, then the overall cost should be 16 667 EUR.</p>
<p>What is being implied by a financial model in the grant agreement? The budget?</p>	<p>It's a form of finance report. There is a specific template for it.</p>
