We are required to specify prices for video materials as well as other related services, but we are not entirely sure what should be included in the Daily Fee. Does it refer to the amount we should indicate for one working day of performing tasks (e.g., shooting, editing, material preparation), or should this amount also cover additional costs, such as transportation, equipment rental, or fees for specialists involved in the process?	A unit fee refers to time-based units as the price for a day of work. The price (global fee) of each deliverable (i.e. service such as video or film production) is calculated on the basis of the unit fee specified in the Framework contract as a daily fee.  Thus, the unit fee (i.e. daily fee) is calculated as an all-inclusive average cost of services to be provided per one working day of performing tasks (e.g., shooting, editing, material preparation as well as other additional costs, such as transportation, equipment rental, or fees for specialists involved in the process, etc.).  Hence, the global (total) fee for a certain deliverable under the Order Form (i.e. service such as video or film production) is calculated as "daily fee x number of days".

Does it mean that the CV for one person from our agency team (which will be involved for provision of services) should be no more than 4 pages? Please clarify.

Section G of the Tender File (Documents to be provided) clearly states terms and conditions for Legal persons, namely, that there should be provided a description of the proposed team consisting of CVs of professional team members/consultants expected to work on the potential project within the Lot(s) applied. There is no specific limitation of volume of such a team description, however, it is recommended that all team members' CVs should be concise, preferably in Europass format, clearly demonstrating the respective expertise and experience and that each participant meets the eligibility criteria.
