**Description:** The Convention on Cybercrime was opened for signature in Budapest, Hungary, in November 2001. This side event is aimed at identifying the ingredients that permitted broad acceptance and implementation of this treaty in practice during the past two decades. Lessons learnt may provide useful insights for the work of the AHC:

- ▶ The [Convention and its Protocols](#): designing common standards for different legal systems
- ▶ Safeguards and conditions to meet human rights and rule of law requirements
- ▶ Setting up an effective follow up mechanism: the [Cybercrime Convention Committee](#), T-CY
- ▶ Adopting [domestic legislation](#) to meet the requirements of the Convention
- ▶ Strengthening criminal justice capacities to investigate, prosecute, adjudicate and cooperate: the [Cybercrime Programme Office of the Council of Europe](#) (C-PROC) in Bucharest, Romania
- ▶ Developing additional tools to meet the challenge of e-evidence: the [Second Additional Protocol on enhanced cooperation and disclosure of electronic evidence](#)
