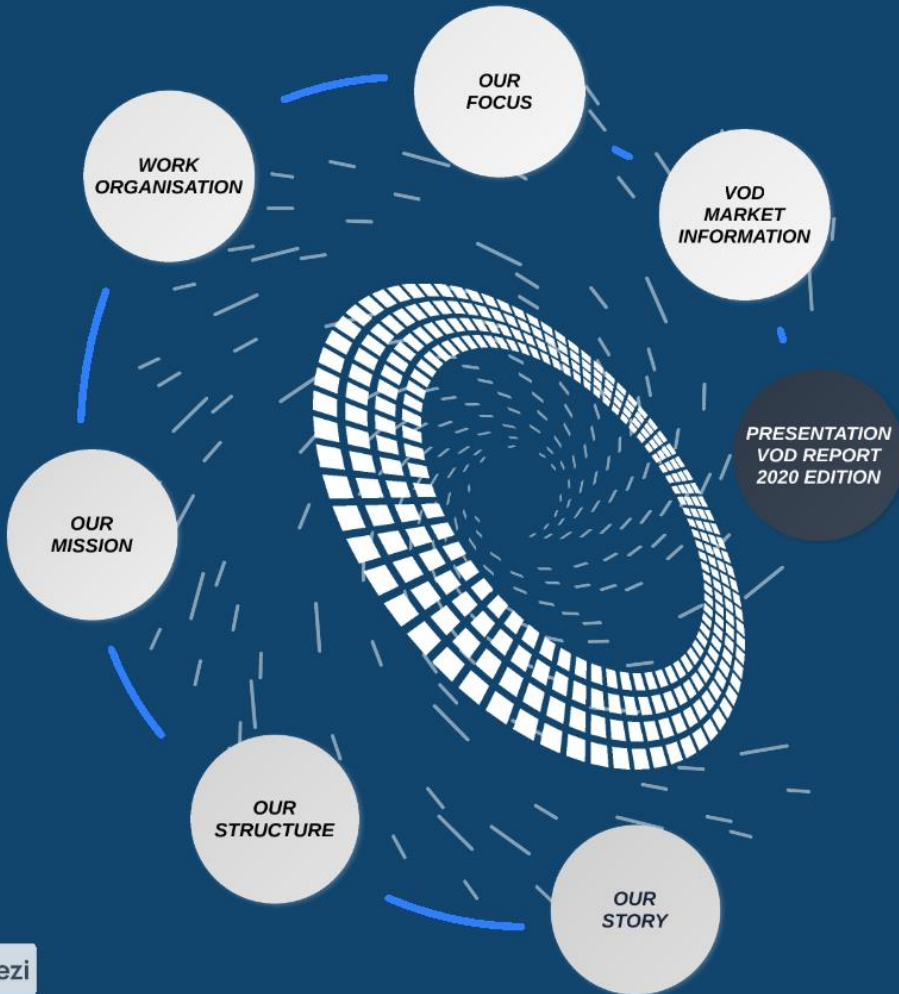

Created in [1992](#) in Strasbourg

To provide much needed information
on the audiovisual industries in Europe

Members come from national culture or telecommunications ministries, or regulatory bodies, or film institutes

They meet twice a year and green light our action plan and budget

Advisory Committee

All major AV industry interest groups represented

39 different international and European organisations in this body *as is EUROVOD*

They meet once a year in Strasbourg and give us grass roots feedback about the information that the AV industries need for their work

Our networks

Over 1 000 international partners, providers and correspondents

Market Department networks

EFARN network: the Heads of Research and Statistics from film agencies. In the framework of the European Film Agency Directors (EFAD) group.

LUMIERE network: national film agencies, distributors' organisations or market research firms provide Lumiere database cinema admissions data.

LUMIERE VOD network: partners providing data on European film and TV content available on VOD in EU.

MAVISE network: correspondents from European television companies and broadcasters supply key AV services and licences data to feed MAVISE database.

Legal Department networks

IRIS network: legal correspondents throughout Europe report on the latest legal developments in Europe concerning the audiovisual sector. Articles published in the IRIS newsletter and stored in the IRIS MERLIN database.

IRIS editorial board: representatives from our legal network who assist in deciding on the Observatory's legal information and publications.

Purpose and evolution of LUMIERE VOD

Purpose:

- Give **information on the availability of European works on VOD**
- Give **free access** to professionals and public authorities **to metadata** and availability of European works
- Provide **greater transparency on the European VOD market**
- **Data for reports and stats on the European VOD market**
- **Supported by CREATIVE EUROPE of the EU/EC**

Evolution:

- Launched in 2019 with data on **35 000 European films** available in **150 paid VOD catalogues** in 28 European countries, representing 150 000 presences.
- 2021: **integration of TV seasons**
- 2022: addition of **free on-demand services** (AVOD, Replay) and updated front end/search functions
- As of August 2022:
 - **1 019 catalogues** (692 SVOD - 202 TVOD - 125 FOD)
 - 23 countries (in September up to 33 countries)
 - **60 759 European film titles and 24 768 European TV seasons**
 - Representing a presence of 723 588 films and 119 608 TV seasons

The Observatory's back-office and Content library

Purpose:

- **Managing metadata and exploitation data** of films released in cinemas (LUMIERE since 1996) in Europe and films and TV seasons available on VOD in Europe (LUMIERE VOD since 2019)
- **Exploitation data** – admissions for films in cinemas / availability of films and TV seasons on VOD
- **Metadata** – country of production, directors, year of production, IDs, original and alternative titles, genre, production companies
- Major development in 2021 – 2022: **merging our LUMIERE and LUMIERE VOD back-offices** into one
- As of August 2022, exploitation data and metadata on:
 - **173 080 films**
 - **30 843 TV series and 54 096 TV seasons**
- **Next steps: addition of an 'European' label for films and TV seasons**
