# The sample:

- European theatrical feature films
- produced between 2003 an 2017
- released between 2003 and 2018



# Three categories:


- films by female directors (by one or more women);
- films by male directors (by one or more men);
- films by directors of both genders (i.e. a film by two
  - directors, one woman and one man).



## Gender of film directors




☐ 21% of directors of European films are women





■ 49% of women directed only one single film, compared to 40% for men


#### Comparison of output of directors by gender (2003-2017)






☐ Films by female directors represent 17% of films produced between 2003 and 2017

#### European films produced and released by gender of director (2003-2017)






☐ The number of films by female directors is growing ...



... but the share of films directed by women progresses slowly


#### % of European feature films by gender of director and year of production (2003-2017)






☐ In 2017 half of the films by female directors were (presumably) first features

## Breakdown of European presumed first feature films by gender of directors (2017)






# Gender of directors and film genres



### Gender of directors and film genre

☐ The share of documentary films is significantly higher among films directed by women compared to men.

#### Breakdown of European film by film genre, by gender of director (2003-2017)






## Gender of directors and film genre

■ Also, documentaries have been driving the increase in the % of films directed by women ...


#### Breakdown of European films by female directors by film genre and by production year (2003-2017)

... and documentary is the genre with the highest presence of female directors





## **Geographical differences**

☐ France is the country with the highest number of films directed by women ...

## **Geographical differences**

... but the % of female directors is higher in medium-sized production countries ...




Top 10 European production countries based on % of films by female directors (2013-2017)

# Admissions to films by female directors



☐ The % of admissions to films by female directors is lower than the % of films


Admissions to European films by gender of directors and by production capacity clusters (2013-2017)

Country clusters by production volume	% of films by female directors	% of admissions to films by female directors	
<b>High</b> >100 films per year	15%	8%	
<b>Medium</b> Between 30 and 100 films per year	22%	13%	
<b>Low</b> <30 films per year	15%	8%	



☐ In contrast to a slow growth trend in the share of films by female directors, no such trend seems to apply to the share of admissions.

# Female directors in European TV fiction

# The sample:


- European TV/SVOD fiction series
- produced between 2015 and 2017
- >50 000 episodes for which the gender of directors was identified



### **Gender of directors of TV fiction**

- Women represent 19% of directors of European TV fiction active between 2015 and 2017.
- ☐ This share is lower (16%) for high-end TV series (series comprising from three to 13 episodes).

% of female among directors of European TV fiction, by format (2015-2017)






## TV fiction episodes by female directors

■ Between 2015 and 2017, women directed 15% of TV fiction episodes in Europe (14% for high-end TV series).

% TV fiction episodes directed by at least one female director, by format (2015-2017)






## TV fiction episodes by female directors

☐ The share of TV fiction episodes directed by women increased from 12% in 2015 to 18% in 2017.
