## **Examples of achievements of projects funded by the HRTF**

- ▶ The HRTF contribution enabled the translation and dissemination of key case-law and related materials into national languages in Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Georgia, Montenegro, the Republic of Moldova, Serbia, "the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia", Turkey and Ukraine.
- ▶ A project in favour of Moldova addressed major issues in the national judicial system preventing the effective implementation of the Convention standards. It contributed to the strengthening of the capacities of Moldovan courts as regards interpretation and uniform application of the Convention and the case law of the Court, as well as of the national training institution for judges and prosecutors.
- ▶ A project supporting Public Monitoring Committees (PMC) in the Russian Federation contributed to developing skills and capacities of leading experts, allowing them to carry out detention monitoring. It has also delivered training and support to PMC members and other target groups of people, such as law enforcement officers, prosecutors, judges, and ombudsman staff to support improvement of detention conditions and reduction of instances of ill-treatment.
