Possible scope & structure of Guidelines

Preamble (§1-12)

- ✓ Usually short (2 pages)
- ✓ Reasons for adopting the guidelines and their objective(s)
- ✓ Recalls relevant commitments/standards

Operational part (§13-14)

- ✓ Broad objective of the guidelines & referring to the practical measures
- ✓ Monitoring
- ✓ Dissemination

Measures (§15-80)

- ✓ Objectives, scope, general principles
- ✓ Listing of measures recommended for member states

Reporting and evaluation (§81-82)



Proposed content of Guidelines (1)

Scope and fundamental principles

- ✓ Mandate given by the CM: gender equality policies and policies to combat violence against women
- ✓ Based on existing legal and policy framework on gender equality
- ✓ Takes account of work of other international organisations, CoE sectors (GREVIO) and relevant NGOs
- ✓ Takes account of GEC explanatory study (2021)
- ✓ Takes account of research & events (ex: ICMEO conferences)



Proposed content of Guidelines (2)

Five types of measures for member states

- 1. Measures focusing on countering resistance to gender equality and on men and boys becoming allies
- ✓ Care issues and conciliation measures
- ✓ Measures related to equal parenthood
- Measures to address anti-gender / anti-feminist movements

2.Measures focusing on men and boys as agents of change towards women's rights and gender equality

- ✓ Practical proposals on political decision-makers
- ✓ Measures to foster accountability and non-toxic leadership
- ✓ Measures on training



Proposed content of Guidelines (3)

- 3. Measures to reduce the negative impacts of gender inequalities on men and boys
- Measures related to education
- Measures related to sexuality education
- ✓ Measures related to health
- 4. Measures to strengthen the role of men and boys in combating violence against women
- ✓ Focus on prevention
- ✓ Measures on witnesses and bystanders of VAW
- ✓ Child custody issues
- ✓ Issue of impunity/perpetrators' programmes



Proposed content of guidelines (4)

5.Development and dissemination of scientific research and data on gender inequality and women's rights

- ✓ All measures related to knowledge building, including sectoral measures addressed in other sections (care work, health, education)
- ✓ Collection of regular reliable sex-disaggregated data across policy sectors
- ✓ Promotion of gender equality in scientific research
- ✓ Inclusion of intersectional approach in research
- ✓ Promotion of gender-sensitive language and communication
- **Reporting and evaluation**
