Foreword

This presentation focuses on writers and directors of EU27+UK theatrical films and TV fiction released between 2015 and 2020.

Sources of the data:

- The Observatory, for theatrical films and their directors and for TV fiction titles.
- IMDB public files, for theatrical films writers and TV fiction directors and writers.
- Level of analysis:
 - By film.
 - By episode for TV series.
- Identification rate:
- The identification rate of directors and writers (i.e. the share of films or TV episodes for which at least one director or one writer has been identified) varies between categories of work: close to 100% for film directors; about 80% for film writers and short TV series directors and writers; about 60% for long-running daily telenovelas and soaps. The latter have been excluded from the analysis when relevant.

Precarity in numbers




Are TV series the lifeline of filmmakers?



To which extent film and TV fiction creators overlap?

Only 11% of directors and 7% of writers worked both for film and TV between 2015 and 2020





New ways of creating



The European "film d'auteur" model in figures

The "film d'auteur" model, i.e. a work written and directed by the same creator, is much more prevalent in film than in TV fiction

Films with a creator credited as director and screen writer

What happened to 2015 fiction film directors?

Out of 100 directors who directed a <u>live-action</u> film in 2015:



36 directed at least another film

between 2016 and 2020

11 did not direct any other film but directed at least one TV fiction episode

6 did not direct any other film or any TV fiction episode but wrote at least one film or one TV episode

47 were not active anymore



What happened to 2015 fiction film writers?

Out of 100 writers who wrote a live-action film in 2015:



37 wrote at least another film

between 2016 and 2020

7 did not write any other film but directed at least one TV fiction episode

3 did not write any other film or any TV fiction episode but directed at least one film or one TV episode

53 were not active anymore
