



### Partial Agreement on Youth Mobility through the Youth Card

# «Youth Perspectives in action: Council of Europe's Partial Agreements after the Reykjavik Summit» Workshop on co-operation

11-12 March 2025 Room 3.1 European Youth Centre Strasbourg

The Council of Europe, in line with its member States's requests, has always encouraged transversal co-operation between its various sectors. The Reykjavik Declaration adopted by the Heads of State and Government at the 4th Council of Europe Summit in May 2023 has prescibed the integration of a "youth perspective" into the intergovernmental work of the Council of Europe, this being also the case for the Partial Agreements.

In order to **start the implementation** of this objective and with the **aim** to explore new avenues of co-operation between the Partial Agreement on Youth Mobility through the Youth Card and other Council of Europe Partial Agreements, the "Ideas' Workshop" is organised on 11-12 March 2025 in the European Youth centre in Strasbourg.

The Partial Agreement's member States, EYCA member organisations, partners (ERYICA, YFJ), the secretariat and the elected representatives of the various Council of Europe Partial Agreements will discuss, among other things, ways of enhancing the use of the European Youth Card as an effective tool of communication and flow of information between the governments and the young people, as well as between the young people and the CoE Partial Agreements: currently 9.2 mln young people are youth card-holders in Europe.

The EDQM, EPA, EPAS and the Pompidou Group has been identified by the Board of Co-ordination of the youth sector's Partial Agreement (52<sup>nd</sup> meeting, 12 November 2024) as the first four priority Partial Agreements for developing co-operation given their direct relevance to the concerns and needs of the young people.

#### Objectives of the event are:

- 1) to serve as a platform for the stakeholders of the Partial Agreements, member States, EYCA organisations, young people and other partners to get acquainted with each other through:
- short presentations of their structure and work;
- sharing about respective interests, expectations, perceptions or challenges and uncertanties regarding the youth perspective;
- 2) to determine pathways, and if possible, some concrete possibilities for co-operation within the respective work programmes of 2025, 2026 and 2027 (including budgetary possibilities), with a possibility of tripartite events.
